As you approach Redwater you will note the tallest oil derrick in North America on the skyline. This historical landmark is set immediately adjacent to Pembina Place and next to the campground and will serve as your reference point for all the AGM and Workshop connections. The campground in Redwater is approximately one (1) block from Pembina Place, the site of the 2025 ACOPA AGM and Workshop activities. Located adjacent to the main highway entrance, the conveniently located campground has a total of 11 sites serviced by electricity only. Water and sani dump are located near by and are free. Each site has a picnic table and tenting or additional car parking is located on the west side of the campground. The Town of Redwater has initiated an online payment program by using a smart phone and a QR code located on site. Additionally, the Town Office and Swimming Pool can accept campground payments. Showers are available during pool hours by



paying the daily admission fee for the pool which is located adjacent to the campground. Currently this cost is \$7.00 for adults and \$5.00 for seniors.
